Collaboration Principles

1. **Ecosystem benefit:** Ensure that every collaboration has a wider ecosystem benefit or gain and is aligned to SENVIC's overall strategy
2. **Clear communication:** Establish open lines of communication among all collaborators and provide opportunities for partners to offer input on proposals / project delivery.
3. **Everyone is accountable:** Agree on a framework for accountability by defining roles and responsibilities and clarifying expectations from the outset.
4. **Shared decision-making:** implement a collaborative decision-making process, including regular meetings and check-ins for decision-making, to track progress and manage obstacles.
5. **Transparent budgeting:** Develop a clear and detailed budget that reflects the contributions and needs of each collaborator, ensuring transparency in funding allocation.
6. **Defined metrics for success:** Agree on shared metrics to evaluate the project's success, ensuring all collaborators have a stake in achieving outcomes.
7. **Conflict of interest management:** Establish a process for disclosing and managing any potential conflicts of interest among collaborators.
8. **Ethical compliance:** Ensure all collaborators adhere to ethical standards and guidelines related to funding, research and collaborations.
